How can you apply for UK Student Visa?

You can only apply for one after receiving a CAS certificate from your university. In case you have been awarded any study abroad scholarship, you must ensure that your CAS certificate specifically mentions that scholarship. It is noteworthy to remember that you must apply for a visa three months prior to the beginning of your course. In usual circumstances, you will get your visa within three weeks of applying. 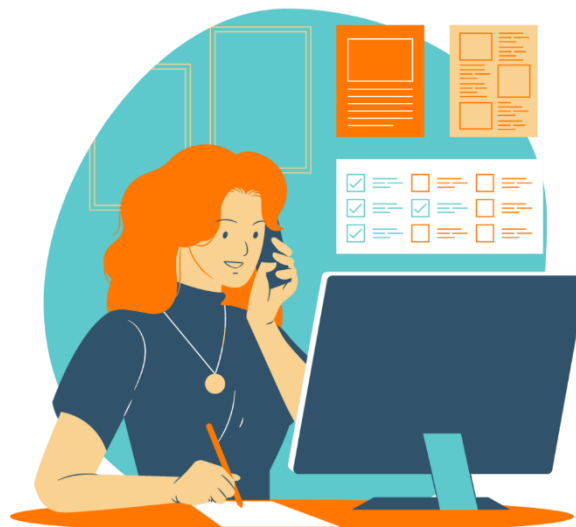


Work while you study
