# Credit System Of the USA

The credit system binds the public and private universities of the US together. You can earn credits for courses and use them for the completion of a program. The typical requirement is 3 to 5 credits per course for a bachelor's degree. For a master's degree, you will need 3 to 4 credits per year. Typically, 120 to 130 credits are required to complete a bachelor's degree, and 30 to 64 credits are needed to finish a master's degree. The accommodative credit system of the USA makes the country one of the best places to study abroad. The US educational system uses GPA or the Grade Point Average. 4.0 represents an A grade, and 0.0 is equivalent to the F grade. Different programs have different GPA requirements.

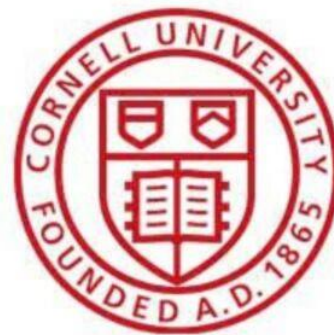

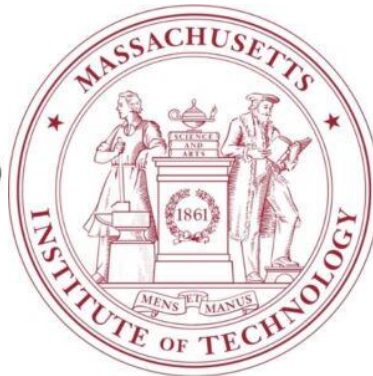

# Techniques to opt for a student VISA IN THE USA

The F-1 visa is, generally speaking, is the visa that international students need to attend higher education institutions in the USA. The various requirements to obtain an F-1 visa include a language training course, proof of financial records, identification documents, and so forth. The method to obtain an F1 Visa is simple and straight. You need an I-20 form before applying for a student visa to the USA. The various steps that you need to follow the applying for a student visa are –

**1** Apply for the University of your choice and wait for the acceptance letter. You should remember that the university you are opting for should be certified by the SEVP. After being accepted, you can begin the process of visa application.

**2** Get an I-20 form from your college.

**3** Submit your 1-901 SEVIS fee payment of USD 200. To pay the SEVIS fee, you will have to provide the following information – Name, address, birth date, email address, country of birth, school code on your I-20 form, and SEVIS identification number listed on the I-20 form.

**4** Identifying the nearest US Embassy or consulate and prepare for your interview.

**5** Complete the DS-160 Visa Application.

**6** Schedule your interview at your desired consulate or embassy. You might have to pay a fee of USD 160.

**7** Attend the interview. While attending the interview, you need the following documents for verification – passport, visa photo, printed DS-160 barcode page, and I-20 form.

**8** Payment of insurance fee.



# Work Opportunities in USA

The F1 visa, the student visa, allows you to work in the USA but only under certain conditions. You have to comply with the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services regulations. You can opt for free on-campus employment. There are four off-campus employment categories available for international students –

- ❖ On Campus Jobs

- ❖ CPT
- ❖ Economic challenges
- ❖ International hubs



Most students get the opportunity to opt for on-campus employment. It is a category that is analyzed leniently by the USCIS. It is noteworthy to mention that the on-campus employment of many schools and colleges in the US is limited. Even though you obtain a job on campus, you won't be able to depend on it for financial resources. Another disadvantage of on-campus jobs is that they are unrelated to your studies. Many schools mandate that you procure permission from the International Student Office before accepting any on-campus employment. Certain USS universities may not permit on-campus employment for international students during the first semester.
